1. Go to the Plugins menu and select the Plugin Manager. Find and select NppFTP plugin from the list of plugins and install it. Upon completion, the NppFTP plugin will appear on the list of the Plugins menu. Then choose "Show NppFTP Window" as below.

2. In the Show NppFTP Window, click the connection icon and then enter login credentials to the server. Then you will see the files and directories on the server side.
